

## MOSES AT THE MOUNTAINS[A1]

### I. MOSES AT MOUNT HOREB

A. **Exodus 3:1-17**

At Mount Horeb, Moses was called by God to deliver His people.

B. **Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16**

We are called to do likewise.

C. **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 9:16; Acts 4:18-20**

We should do so with determination!

### II. MOSES AT MOUNT SINAI

A. **Exodus 19:1-25**

At Mount Sinai, God impressed upon Moses and the people His reverence.

B. **Psalms 89:7**

He is to be esteemed sacred by all.

C. **Exodus 31:18**

At Mount Sinai, Moses received from God the law for Israel.

1. **Galatians 3:23-25**

We are no longer bound to keep that same law.

2. **James 1:22-25; 2:12; 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 9:21**

Nevertheless, in Christ, there is a law to keep.

### III. MOSES AT MOUNT NEBO

A. **Deuteronomy 3:23-27; 32:48-52; 34:1-8**

At Mount Nebo (Pisgah), Moses died in view of the promised land, yet outside it.

B. **Numbers 20:1-12**

This happened as the result of sin.

- C. **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:9-10**  
Sin precludes entry to the promised land of heaven.
- D. **2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 12:1-14; Luke 23:39-43**  
Even sin that has been repented of often bears consequences.
- E. **Jude 9; Deuteronomy 29:29**  
Some things, such as the location of Moses' corpse, remain unknown.

#### IV. MOSES AT THE HOLY MOUNTAIN

- A. **Luke 9:28-36; 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 1:16-18**  
At the holy mountain, Moses was present for the glorification of Christ in His transfiguration.
- B. **Deuteronomy 18:15-19; 34:10-12; John 1:45; Acts 3:13-26; Hebrews 3:1-6**  
In the transfiguration, Christ's superiority over Moses was evident. Moses, and all the prophets who followed him, foretold of Christ, the great prophet who would eventually come.
- C. **Revelation 15:3-4; Exodus 15:1-19; Deuteronomy 32:22, 30-44**  
The heavenly song of Moses is a song of praise for Christ, even as his earthly songs gave praise to God.
