THE MOST DANGEROUS WOMAN IN ENGLAND

She was, so Adolph Hitler once said, "the most dangerous woman in England". Who was she? A spy? A nuclear scientist, on the verge of discovering the ultimate weapon? She outlived Hitler, Goering, Himmler, and Mengele, the gruesome foursome. Churchill, Roosevelt, Montgomery, and MacArthur, the men who stood for something right, too, have long been dead. "A CHILD LEFT TO HIMSELF"

Neglect is one of the cruelest forms of child abuse. That a mother or father might deprive a child of his basic needs, such as food or clothing, is shameful. No less criminal is the act of depriving a child of necessary discipline, for it is written, "The rod and rebuke give wisdom, but a child left to himself brings shame to his mother" (Proverbs 29:15).

Strange as it may seem to the modern mind, an undisciplined child is an unloved child. Solomon penned, "He who spares his rod hates his son, but he who loves him disciplines him promptly" (Proverbs 13:24). Parents, if you love your children, do not withhold punishment when it is due them; yes and such punishment must be administered swiftly. Don't delay until they are beyond control to introduce spanking to your children. By then, it will seem so strange to them that they will only be confused by it. Rather, "Chasten your son while there is hope, and do not set your heart on his destruction" (Proverbs 19:18).

"Do not withhold correction from a child, for if you beat him with a rod, he will not die. You shall beat him with a rod, and deliver his soul from hell" [Proverbs 23:13-14]. Mothers and fathers must realize that the pain they inflict on their children's backsides is minimal compared to the relentless torture they would otherwise undergo in hell. "Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it" [Hebrews 12:11]. Parents, let your little ones be "trained by it," for if you "Train up a child in the way he should go... when he is old he will not depart from it" [Proverbs 22:6].

Do not be so naïve as to think that your young ones can be reasoned with. Before they can form coherent sentences themselves, do you seriously expect them to understand your explanations? Until they are old enough to be reasoned with, they will only learn at the end of their father's belt or their mother's wooden spoon. "Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; the rod of correction will drive it far from him" (Proverbs 22:15).

For parents suffering constant exhaustion from seemingly uncontrollable children, relief is but a swat away. "Correct your son, and he will give you rest; yes, he will give delight to your soul" (Proverbs 29:17).
